This year marks the 100th anniversary of Armistice's Day. We want to celebrate the 100 years by honoring J. W. Stine for his service; especially since he recently celebrated his 100th birthday. Thanksgiving Breakfast – Friday, November 16th

The Thanksgiving breakfast for grades 1st – 8th will be on Friday, November 16th at 9:30am. We will gather in the Commons to share a breakfast consisting of fruit, juice and various breads.

Families are asked to supply the following food items:

First and Second grades – any variety of sweet bread (banana, cranberry, pumpkin) **NO NUTS**

Third and Fourth grades – variety of cut up fruit or fruit salad

Fifth and Sixth grades – fruit juices (apple, cranberry, orange, etc.) One quart per person should be sufficient.

Seventh and Eighth grades – forks, spoons, napkins, 8 ounce cups and plates

We will be preparing the feast that morning. If you can help, plan to stay when you drop off your children.
