### The Impact of Simple Acts of Kindness

Ten years ago this year our third and fourth graders started knitting hats for the elderly and those who have cancer and are undergoing treatment. Many students have taken the skill they learned in third grade and have used it for their own outreach to others. Many have gone on to make hats for babies in their families. Last year we knitted baby hats for the American Heart Association when the project was seen on KPLC. Grace Simien, now in 7<sup>th</sup> grade, went on to make a couple of dozen hats for her SPARK Goods and Services Fair at the Civic Center. The proceeds were donated to a charitable cause.

Natalie Clemmons, senior in high school, knitted tiny hats to be covers for her golf clubs. We also sell a few hats at the Farmers' Market in the winter. This project is so meaningful and we are thankful that we can show children how to a handmade gift that is needed and special.

Another handmade gift is the fourth graders' project making blankets. Four yards of fleece which the children select starts this project. They cut and tie the ends all around to make a thick fringed blanket. These blankets are given to both our Little Free Pantry here on our campus and to Family and Youth for foster children who come and need something of their very own.

We have also decorated beautiful cards for Drake Quibodeaux. He is the eight-year-old Vinton boy with a terminal brain tumor. He wanted 190 cards for Christmas and at last count he had 14,000! We are a part of this number.



It is so awesome to see the work and generosity of our students who want to help others. Kids helping kids and adults is a wonderful sight to see.
