## School Zone Safety Rules

Most school zones have a speed limit of 25 miles per hour from 7:00am to 9:00am and again from 2:00pm to 4:00pm on weekdays. The normal posted speed limit applies to the school zones on weekends and 9:00am until 2:00pm on week days.

Calcasieu parish authorities also want to remind drivers of several state laws that apply in a school zone:

- Yield the right-of-way for pedestrians in crosswalks or those crossing roadways.
- When a school bus is picking up or dropping off students on a roadway drivers must stop at least 30 feet from either direction.
- Pay attention to the “no right on red” signs in school zone intersections.
- It is illegal to use a cell phone in a school zone during the posted pick up and drop off times.

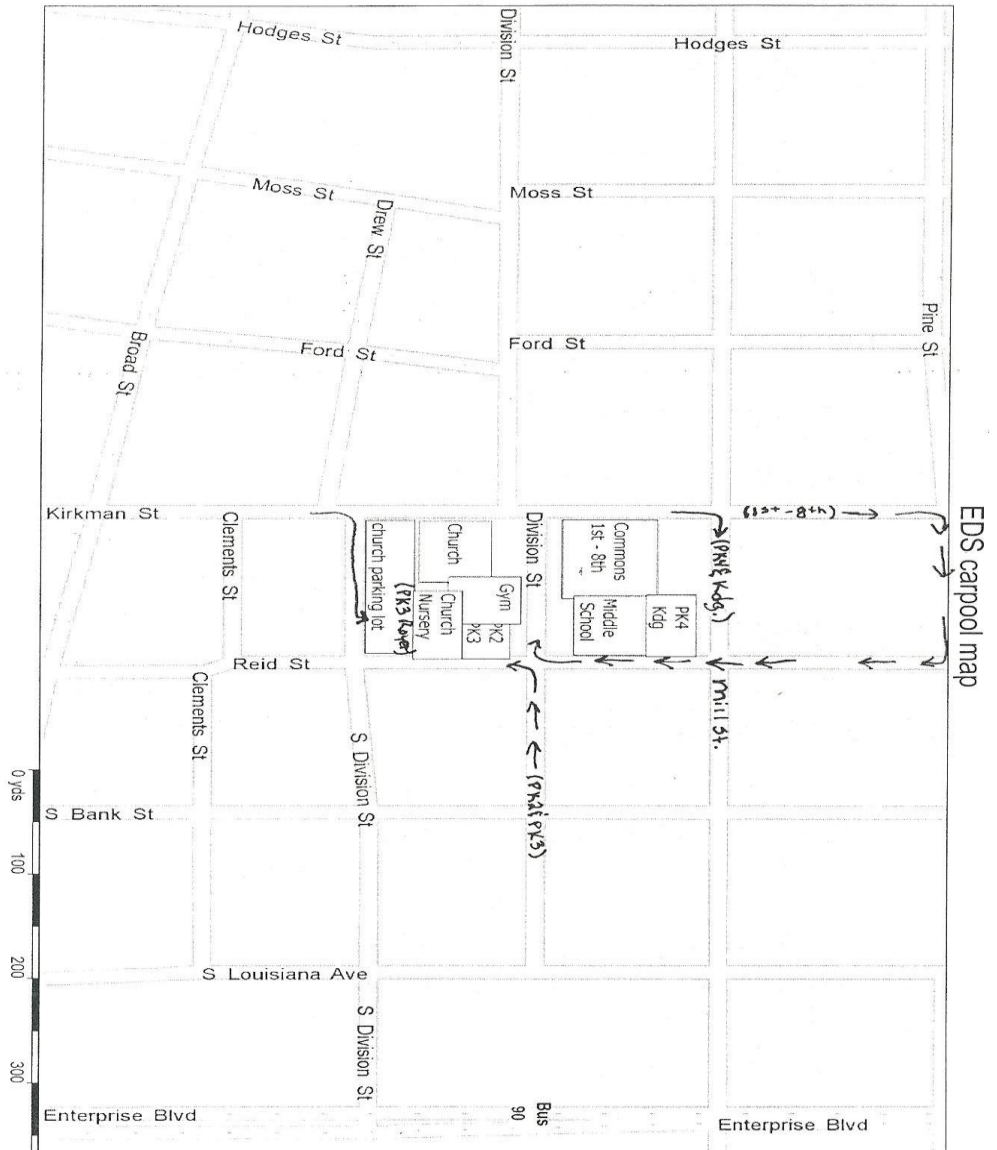
The only time you don’t have to stop for a school bus is when the bus is in a loading zone off the roadway, or when the bus is on a separated road, like one that has a median dividing the two.

## Carpool Guidelines

We have included a carpool map along with carpool instructions for you to follow in dropping off and picking up children. For the safety of our children, *it is imperative that you follow these directions!*

There are a few other things we would like to mention to ensure the safety of all students, parents, and teachers and help us to get through carpool quickly and safely as possible.

1. Please attach your carpool sign (given on the *meet your teacher day*) to the passenger side visor. It is much easier to see than in the window. Keep it visible until you leave the carpool lines. Use your sign every day, all year.
2. Please do not stop on the crosswalk. These white lines are designated for street crossers.
3. Make eye contact with the Safety Patrol student holding the STOP sign before pulling up or driving off.
4. Load students only in the lane that is adjacent to the covered walkway.
5. Please help students load as quickly as possible.
6. Note that the corner of Reid and South Division is a **four-way** stop.
7. The EDS carpool is a “**No Cell Phone Zone**”.
8. Do not park in the handicapped spaces unless you have handicapped tags visible.
9. Please be courteous.
10. First – 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents should not enter the carpool line on Mill Street. Please use Pine Street ONLY.

**REMEMBER:**

- Observe all school zone speed limits, school crossings and laws that apply to school uses. Most importantly, **WATCH FOR KIDS!**
- The school zone speed limit is 25 mph between the hours of 7:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on school days.

**DRIVERS ARE REQUIRED BY STATE LAW TO:**

- Yield the right-of-way by slowing down or stopping for pedestrians crossing a roadway at a crosswalk
- When a school bus loading or unloading children, you must stop at least 30 feet from either direction.
- Observe the "No Right on Red" signs located in school zone intersections.



**PLEASE BE ADVISED:**

That under Louisiana Revised Statute Title 50:508 it is **ILLEGAL** to use a cellular device in a posted school zone during school pick-up and drop-off times.

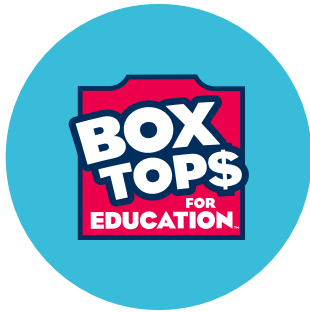

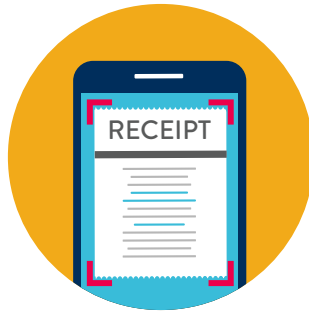
