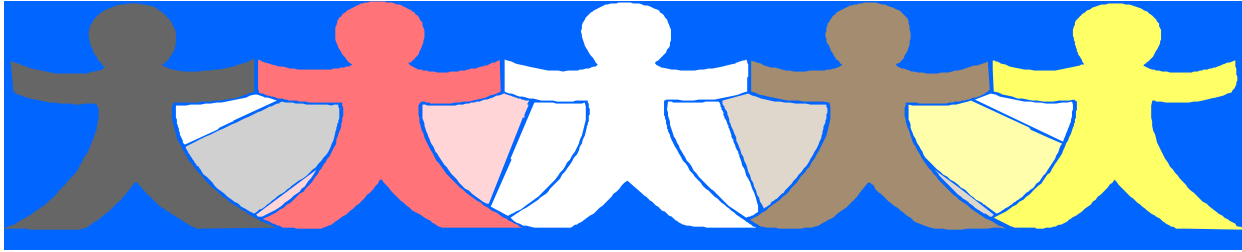
Thanks to all who came out for PK2-PK3 Family Fun Night. It was a fun and joyous event!
